How to Get Rid of Fleas

Combine equal parts of 20 Mule Team Borax and table salt. Sprinkle under furniture cushions and on carpets. Work into carpets with broom-vacuum to eliminate excess. This will dehydrate fleas and larvae.

Spray yard with MALATHION, purchased in garden departments; repeat in 14 days.

Place moth balls or flea collars in vacuum cleaner bag to kill fleas and eggs vacuumed up. Flea collars can be harmful to your pets health.

If your house is heavily infested with fleas, we suggest you have a pest control company spray your house and yard.

Spray flea comb (Lambert Kay #13) with D.F.T. Flea Spray and comb cat or dog. To kill fleas, push them from comb into a mixture of water and ammonia into pie pan. DO NOT PLACE COMB IN AMMONIA MIXTURE! Comb pet daily if possible.

Before de-fleaing pet, dampen cotton ball with D.F.T. Flea Spray and rub around pet's ears to prevent fleas from running into ears. DO NOT GET SPRAY INTO EARS.

Remove pet from home and place flea bomb in rooms infested with fleas.

Bathe dog with flea shampoo the same day as spraying yard and bombing house. Environmental control is as important as flea control on the animal.

Treatment should be done 3 times consecutively at an interval of 14 days to control the flea breeding cycle. Once controlled monthly treatment is recommended.

). Pets who have fleas often have worms - check with your veterinarian.
